Promoters Conditions

- 1. The competition will be swum under Swim England laws and Swim England technical rules of swimming and these Promoter's conditions.
- 2. The meet will be held at Hillingdon Sports and Leisure Complex, Gatting Way, Uxbridge, UB8 1ES.
- 3. This is a Level 3, Short Course, Licensed meet in a 25m pool with 8 lanes, anti-wave lane ropes and electronic timing system with scoreboard.
- 4. A secondary strobe will be available to swimmers requiring one.
- 5. This meet is first-come, first-served.
- 6. Entries open on Monday 7th April 2025 and close on Thursday 22nd May 2025 or earlier if the meet is full.
- 7. All entries must not be faster that the Upper Time Limits and appear on Swim England Rankings. Qualifying times are short course but long course conversions to short course will be accepted. No Time entries are not accepted.
- 8. Entries may be restricted to ensure the smooth running of the meet and to keep the session times within appropriate timescales. Slowest times in each age group will be rejected in oversubscribed events. Acceptance into all events applied for cannot therefore be guaranteed. Refunds will be given for any entries rejected.
- 9. Details of accepted and rejected entries will be published on our website as soon as possible after the closing date. Final information and session times will also be confirmed to clubs and appear on the website.
- 10. Age is at midnight on 8th June 2025, swimmers must be 9 years of age and above.
- 11. Age Groups: 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14 and 15/over
- 12. The events are 50m, 100m & 200m Freestyle, 50m & 100m Backstroke, Breaststroke and Butterfly and 200m Individual Medley.
- 13. Awards will be given to the first 3 in each age group, open/male and female, in each event.
- 14. The entry fee is £8.50 per event. No refunds will be given except for rejected swims.





- 15. There will be no Time Trials available.
- 16. Over the top starts will be used at the Referees' discretion.
- 17. The female category is for birth sex females in accordance with Swim England's Transgender and Non-Binary Competition Policy. By entering the "Female" category, a swimmer confirms that their birth sex is female.
- 18. A designated officer should make all club entries, and that same person must make all communications with the meet organisers.
- 19. The electronic club summary entry form is available via this <u>LINK</u>. The club entry file should be submitted with the electronic club summary entry form. Full payment by Bank Transfer to Hillingdon SC should be made when the form is submitted, banking details are confirmed in the club summary form. Please use club name as reference.
- 20. Swim meet entries will be managed via computer and available via the internet.
- 21. Results will be emailed to British Swimming for inclusion in the national Rankings database.
- 22. Clubs with 15 or more swimmers entered into the meet are requested to provide a minimum of two official for all sessions in which the club has swimmers, preferably more if possible.
- 23. All swimming officials will be offered expenses please contact the Officials Organiser officials@hillingdonsc.co.uk
- 24. Officials should follow this <u>LINK</u> to sign-up to officiate at the meet.
- 25. Coaches/Team Manager poolside passes are available at a cost of £10.00 for Saturday and £15.00 for Sunday. Passes will include admittance to all sessions, light refreshments on Saturday and lunch on Sunday. Poolside passes must be applied for in advance via this LINK by Thursday 5th June 2025.
- 26. Withdrawals after the entry deadline must be made via this <u>LINK</u> until 12:00noon on Saturday 7 June 2025. Withdrawals can also be made poolside each day of the meet at the Tech Desk before the start of the warm-up for each session. Withdrawal forms will be available at the desk.
- 27. Refunds are not available for withdrawals unless medical and supported with appropriate evidence which must be submitted to the promoter by Monday 9th June 2025.
- 28. During warm-up swimmers and coaches must ensure that they take no action that would endanger themselves or others. Swimmers should swim in the direction indicated. Sprint lanes will be announced.
- 29. The depth of the water at the start and turn ends is 2 meters.
- 30. A swim down pool will be available for use throughout the duration of the meet, except whilst warm-up is available. Swimmers are expected to respect other swimmers in and around the facility and surrounding area whilst at the meet.





- 31. The instructions of the pool lifeguard and/or Hillingdon SC meet management staff must be followed. Hillingdon Sports and Leisure Complex staff reserve the right to close this facility.
- 32. Competitors are requested NOT to bring large kit bags poolside for safety reasons. Lockers are available, £1 (refundable). Small poolside bags should be used.
- 33. Competitors must wear appropriate clothing and footwear when leaving poolside to access dry areas of the facility, including the spectator gallery.
- 34. Supervision ratios must be followed as per <u>Swim England Supervision Policy</u> and it is the visiting clubs responsibility to ensure that this is adhered to.
- 35. Hillingdon Sports and Leisure Complex and Hillingdon SC shall not be responsible for the loss of property for any reason.
- 36. The Data Protection Act 2018 requires us to provide you with certain information and to obtain your consent before processing data about you. Processing includes obtaining, recording, holding, disclosing, destruction or retaining information. We require certain personal data for the purposes of making entries to the competition, managing the meet and the submission of results to Rankings. The information provided by you will be processed in accordance with the Data Protection Act 2018. Consent to process such personal data is deemed to have been given by submission of the entry. Where the personal data of competitors, officials, coaches/tea managers has been passed to us by a third party such as a club rather than by the individuals themselves, we rely on the third party to ensure consent has been obtained.
- 37. Anyone wishing to use a camera, mobile phone camera, or video camera should adhere to the updated guidance in Swim England Wavepower Section 3 on the use of images and restrict to their own child and their own private use with no posting on social medial or similar platforms.
- 38. Flash photography is not permitted at the start of any heat.
- 39. The use of Mobile Phones or any device with photographic or filming capabilities in the changing rooms is prohibited at all times. Swimmers found in breach will be required to leave the meet immediately.
- 40. No spectators are permitted in the changing rooms at any time.
